Douglas County Libraries Mill Levy Resolution

Whereas, an initiative proposal has been certified for the Douglas County Library District for the November 6, 2007 to authorize a mill levy increase of 1.25 mills;

Whereas, it is important to the Town of Castle Rock to maintain the high level of services provided by the Douglas County Library District; and

Whereas, the Douglas County Libraries has a proven track record of fiscal responsibility and has been recognized as seventh best library system in the nation by the Hennen's American Public Library Ratings (HAPLR) in our population group; and

Whereas, the purpose of this initiative is to raise the mill levy in order to improve the accessibility of library services through the purchase and expansion of books, library materials, Internet and computer access and the construction and operation of library faculties in Douglas County; and

Whereas, the Douglas County Libraries has a proven record of providing businesses with data base research, technology services and meeting room space, as well as providing a significant value to the education and development of the Castle Rock Community; and

Whereas, the Douglas County Libraries has committed to be a full partner with the Castle Rock Chamber of Commerce, Economic Development Council and Douglas County in the Town's economic gardening initiative – assisting businesses with marketing, finance and financial management information; and

Now Therefore, Be It Resolved On This 4th Day of October 2007 By The Board Of Directors Of The Castle Rock Economic Development Council That:

CREDCO hereby supports the Douglas County Libraries' request for a 1.25 mill levy increase and encourages Town of Castle Rock residents and business owners to vote yes on the issue.
